

## Kaspars Antess' solo concert

On September 29th at 3:00 PM, the Ventspils Cultural Center will host a solo concert by Kaspars Antess, a schlager musician born in Ventspils. In the program titled "Mēs satiksimies"

songs will also be premiered at this concert. With this concert, Antess celebrates 15 years of songwriting, which began in 2009 with his first work "Ir tikai rīts" ("It's Just Morning"). This	
marked the start of his collaboration with lyricist Guntars Račs, together creating 10 original songs featured on his debut album "Neskaties atpakaļ." Later, Kaspars began writing his own	& +37163624796
lyrics, and his compositions have been performed by other artists, including Dzintars Čīča. For the song "Likteņlīnijas," Antess received the Copyright Infinity Award in 2018; this track was the	
most played song on Latvian Radio 2 in 2016 and was named "Schlager Song of the Year" by "Latvijas Šlāgeraptauja."	☑ kulturas.centrs@ventspils.lv
